Comparing & Ordering Fractions Lesson Plan | Study.com

Tell student that these fractions have the same denominator. Model how to compare 3/8 and 6/8 using fraction strips. Explicitly tell students that when the denominators are like, or the same, the numerator that is largest is the fraction that is biggest. So, 3/8 < 6/8. Guided Practice: Say: Now we are going to compare fraction with unlike denominator.

Thematic Unit Plan: 4th Grade Fractions

In today's lesson, the students learn to compare fractions by using the benchmark fraction 1/2, then justify their answer with fraction strips. This aligns with 4.NF.A2 because the students are comparing two fractions with different numerators and denominators by a benchmark fraction, recording their findings using >, <, or =, then justifying their answer by using fraction strips.

Fourth grade Lesson Comparing Fractions | BetterLesson

Convert these fractions to equivalent fractions with a common denominator in order to compare them. Follow these steps: List out the multiples. Multiples of 6 = 6, 12, 18, 24, Multiples of 3 = 3, 6, 9, 12, The smallest multiple the two denominators have in common is 6.

Comparing and Ordering Fractions Lesson - Turtle Diary

Write the fraction comparisons on the board, such as 1/3 < 2/3. Ask small groups to look at the comparisons on the board and determine if they can identify any patterns. For example, if the denominator is the same, the larger numerator, or top number, is the greater fraction. Explicit Instruction/Teacher modeling.
